### Swim Lessons

#### SWIM CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

The Greenfield Recreation swim program is designed to help swimmers at every level to experience more success and less frustration with learning the fundamentals of swimming. Below are descriptions for each level of the program. All lessons held at the Green River Swimming Area.

#### Wave Runners - ages 3 and 4

Exploration of water activities and readiness. Parent is not with child during lesson.

Level 1 - Water Exploration - ages 5 and above Learn to hold breath under water; float front and back; kick on front and back with help; walk in shallow end.

#### **Level 2 - Primary Skills**

Must have passed Level 1. Learn to swim under water; float without help; flutter kick; swim combined strokes for distance; retrieve object from shallow end.

#### Level 3 - Stroke Readiness

Must have passed Level 2. Bobbing in water over head; learn diving; front and back crawl strokes; elementary backstroke; reverse direction without stopping; tread water for time.

#### **Level 4 - Stroke Development**

Must have passed Level 3. Deep water bobbing; rotary breathing; deep water diving; swim 4 basic strokes for distance; tread water for time with different stroke kicks.



#### **REGISTRATION INFORMATION\***

A Resident: One who resides in The Town of Greenfield.

**A Non-Resident:** One who resides outside of the Town of Greenfield. Only registered participants are permitted in each program. Visitors and guests are strictly prohibited.

Walk-In: In person registrations may be made as soon as you receive your brochure. You can use the drop box next to the front door at the Recreation Dept. or drop off forms at Town Hall Service Center. All registrations are on a first come, first serve PAID basis. Complete entire registration form and sign the WAIVER AGREEMENT. Register early as programs have a minimum and maximum enrollment.

**Mail-In:** Mail-in registration may be made using the registration form at the beginning of this brochure. Include a self-addressed stamped envelope if you need a receipt. All registrations are on a first come, first serve **PAID** basis. Complete entire registration form and sign the **WAIVER AGREEMENT.** Register early as programs have a minimum and maximum enrollment.

**Waiting Lists:** We do maintain wait lists at no cost. We will attempt to offer additional classes for programs with large wait lists.

*Credit Cards:* We accept Visa, Mastercard, and Discover credit cards for program registrations. An additional fee is required. Credit card registrations will be accepted by mail, fax and in person only. All refunds will be applied to credit card.

No phone registrations.

Cancellations: For class cancellations and program changes please call 413-772-1553. Notices will also be posted on face-book or sent through e-news notices. If a program has not met the minimum enrollment requirement one week prior to the first class, it will be cancelled.

**Refunds:** A refund will only be granted when Greenfield Recreation is notified one week PRIOR to the first day of the program. If a refund is distributed, a \$5 administration fee will be assessed.
