

Greenfield Recreation Reopening Plan in accordance with Governor Baker's Four Phased Approach



Phase 1: Start

As of May 28th and is subject to change

Vulnerable individuals should continue to follow "Safer at Home" guidance. All individuals when in public should maximize physical distance and continue to wear face coverings. Gatherings are limited to groups of 10 or less.

Parks and Trails
